EMERGENCY ORDINANCE #99-20

A ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADOPTED ANNUAL FY 1999-2000 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FOR THE DOWN PAYMENT OF A BOILER FOR THE LAUNDROMAT

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel owns the laundromat and contracts for the management and operation of such; and

WHEREAS, a working laundromat is a necessity for the residents of Bethel, and

WHEREAS, the laundromat is in need of a new boiler since the old boiler has been "red tagged" by a State of Alaska inspector;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is not of a general nature and shall not be codified.

SECTION 2. The following is a summary of the change by fund and department:




SECTION 3. The Promissory Note will be recorded as a receivable to recover the loan.
