DESIGNATED LAND FOR THE BETHEL AQUATIC TRAINING AND HEALTH CENTER

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council approved the City Manager to negotiate a contract with Architects Alaska, Inc. on September 12, 2008 for a multi-use recreation center feasibility study and related pre-design work;

WHEREAS, the signed a contract for professional architectural and engineering services between the City of Bethel and Architects Alaska, Inc. was made effective January 6, 2009;


WHEREAS, the proposed site for the Bethel Aquatic Training and Health Center, as determined by the City Planner in spring 2008, is a ten-acre section of land located on the south side of Akiachak Street, across from the Yuut Elitnaurviat property;

WHEREAS, the Administrative Bethel Aquatic Training and Health Center Committee, known informally as the Recreation Center Committee, discussed alternative sites and ultimately recommended to the City Manager that the Bethel Aquatic Training and Health Center be located on the proposed Akiachak Street site;


WHEREAS, as part of the City's contract with Architects Alaska, Inc., surveyors, engineers, and architects have evaluated the proposed site and initiated the schematic design based on the proposed site;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council hereby designates a ten-acre section of land on the South side of Akiachak Street, the exact dimensions and location of which shall be determined by the City Planner, for the purpose of designing and potentially constructing the Bethel Aquatic Training and Health Center;
