

RESOLUTION # 334

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT A BIKE PATH STATE HIGHWAY TO THE AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has approved a grant of \$150,000.00 to the City of Bethel to construct a dirt bike path along 4.3 miles of road beginning at Bethel Airport and ending at Brown's Slough at locations to be determined by the municipality;

WHEREAS, a safety hazard now exists with joggers and bicycle riders forced to use the roadway itself;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is anxious to alleviate this safety hazard and provide a bike path.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to construct a dirt bike path along the State Highway to the airport.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of this grant award.
