A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUCIL RESCINDING RESOLUTION 10-43 AND REINSTATING RESOLUTION 03-26 DESIGNATING CITY-OWNED LAND AS THE SITE FOR A BETHEL POLICE DEPARTMENT FACILITY

WHEREAS, in 2003 the Bethel City Council unanimously passed Resolution 03-26 designating Lots 1 A and B, block 5, City Center Subdivision as the new site for a Bethel police facility;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska in their FY 2010 Budget, awarded the City of Bethel 3 million dollars to construct a new police facility;

WHEREAS, in 2010 the City of Bethel was offered and later awarded a building and land at Lot D8 Phase 2, Blueberry Subdivision for the purpose of law enforcement;

WHEREAS, Resolution 10-43 was passed by a 4-2 vote rescinding Resolution 03-26 and establishing Blueberry Subdivision as the new location for the Bethel police facility;

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the community to construct in a central location, a structurally sound and quality facility to house law enforcement in the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, Lots 1 A and B, block 5, City Center Subdivision provides an adequate amount of land in a central location which would be ideal for construction of a new police facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City of Bethel, City Council, rescinds resolution 10-43 and adopts Resolution 11-03 and in conjunction readopts Resolution 03-26 designating Lots 1A and 1B, Block 5, City Center Subdivision as the new site for a Bethel police facility.
