

RESOLUTION # 488

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, FORGIVING THE PAYMENT OF PENALTY AND INTEREST OWED AS A RESULT OF AN AUDIT, FOR SALES TAX COLLECTORS WHO HAVE PAID QUARTERLY INSTEAD OF MONTHLY AND WHO HAVE BEEN UP TO SEVEN DAY LATE IN MAKING PAYMENTS IN THE PAST.

WHEREAS, the City has undertaken numerous sales tax audits; and

WHEREAS, the audits have shown that several sales tax collectors have paid their taxes quarterly instead of monthly and this was not called to their attention as being in error by the City; and

WHEREAS, due to various factors, a number of sales tax returns were turned in properly but were late; and


WHEREAS, these sales tax collectors have made their payments in good faith and it is only proper to not penalize them by adding penalty and interest.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that the City Manager be authorized to forgive the collection of penalty and interest for those sales tax collectors who have paid sales taxes quarterly instead of monthly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager be authorized to forgive the collection of penalty and interest for those payments made up to 7 days late.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that forgiveness of penalty and interest is only for those payments made prior to July 1, 1986.
