Resolution # 09-07

ESTABLISHING THE NAME OF THE MULTI-USE RECREATION CENTER PROJECT AS THE "BETHEL AQUATIC TRAINING AND HEALTH CENTER"

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council passed Ordinance 07-08, which calls for a budgetary allotment for the planning, construction, operation and maintenance of a multi-purpose center;

WHEREAS, the voters of the City of Bethel increased the sales tax by one percent (1%) for two years, to decrease by one-half percent (0.5%) for the following 18 years, by majority vote during the October 2007 Election;

WHEREAS, the community of Bethel, with approximately 5,900 permanent residents, currently has no public or private facility that offers a range of indoor activities, such as a swimming pool, health and fitness center, or gymnasium on a daily basis;


WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council believes that the designation of the name for the public facility should accurately reflect the intention of the project and should therefore be re-named;


WHEREAS, the Bethel Aquatic Training and Health Center will offer a range of activities in which to engage, such as: swimming, racquetball, volleyball, running, karate, ballet, and aerobics; increasing the overall public health, longevity, employment and entrepreneurship opportunities to residents and visitors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Bethel is hereby in favor of re-naming the Multi-Use Recreation Center to the Bethel Aquatic Training and Health Center to better depict the intention of the facility.
