RESOLUTION #00-08

A RESOLUTION POSTPONING THE ACCEPTANCE OF MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE BIA ROAD

WHEREAS, the road from Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway to the unoccupied Bureau of Indian Affairs facility, and remaining White Alice tower site, is know as the BIA Road; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) currently maintains this road; and

WHEREAS, this road is currently hard surfaced from the junction of Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway to Tsikoyak Subdivision (a/k/a Larson Subdivision); and


WHEREAS, this road was placed in the year 2000-2003 State Transportation Improvement Plan by DOT&PF for structural improvements and transfer of maintenance responsibility to the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has very limited funding, road maintenance personnel and equipment to maintain its current road system responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has committed these limited road maintenance resources to higher priority road systems within the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, is not prepared to accept maintenance responsibility for the non-hard surfaced portion of the BIA Road from the vicinity of Tsikoyak Subdivision to the Bureau of Indian Affairs/White Alice Site.

PASSED AND APPROVED THIS 9th DAY OF MAY 2000, by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed.
