AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL AMENDING ORDINANCE #45, BY REPEALING PARAGRAPH #3 AND ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL; THAT THEY DELETE;

Paragraph 3.

No person may consume, sell, offer for sale, give, furnish or deliver from an authorized licensee any intoxicating liquor on any licensed premises on any Sunday, or on the following holiday:

- A. Christmas, December 25

Paragraph 3 Amended to read:

No person may consume, sell, offer for sale, give, furnish or deliver from an authorized licensee any intoxicating liquor on any licensed premises on any Sunday, or on the following holidays:

- A. New Year's Day - January 1st
- B. Washington's Birthday
- C. Memorial Day
- D. Independence Day - July 4th
- E. Labor Day - First Monday in September
- F. Thanksgiving Day - Fourth Thursday in November
- G. Christmas - December 25th

For the purpose of this Ordinance the aforementioned holidays shall be observed according to the federal designation for the observation of these holidays.
