Ordinance #07-25

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL DESIGNATING THE MAYOR AS A MEMBER-AT-LARGE OF ALL COMMITTEES & COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, the mayor acts as ceremonial head of the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS; the mayor at times has the duty of addressing the public either directly or through the media;

WHEREAS, the mayor may require information from various committees and commissions;

WHEREAS, there are matters which are sometimes addressed by more than one committee or commission.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Addition to Bethel Municipal Code Chapter 2.04.080 This ordinance shall become an addition to section 2.04.080 of the Bethel Municipal Code:

Chapter 2.04.080

Mayoral powers and duties

- A. The mayor is the ceremonial head of the city and shall preside at meetings of the council, sign all ordinances and resolutions passed by the council and execute deeds and other documents on behalf of the city when authorized by the council.
- B. The mayor shall be a member-at-large of all commissions and committees established by the city council. The mayor shall be authorized to participate in all discussions of the commissions and committees but shall have no voting capacity. Attendance by mayor, as an at-large-member, shall not be required.
- C. The vice mayor shall have the powers and perform the duties of the mayor during the absence from the city or temporary disability of the mayor.

D. The mayor and vice mayor, as members of the council, may vote on all council matters.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This chapter shall become effective upon passage by the Bethel City Council.
