

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Bainton called the special meeting of the City Council to order at 7.30 pm.

ROLL CALL

All members present except for Clark.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

M/M by Carpenter, 2nd by Warner to approve the agenda as presented. Voice vote, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

NEW COUNCILMEMBER

Item A: New  
Councilmember

Mayor Bainton announced that Councilmember Clark has formally resigned. M/M by Warner, 2nd by Aloysius to accept the resignation of Councilmember Clark. Voice vote, motion carried.

Mayor Bainton noted that the City will accept written statements of interest to serve on Council until May 15 and that an appointment will be made to fill the vacant Council seat at the May 27 Council meeting.

Item B: PATC  
Expansion

PATC EXPANSION

City Manager Widom reviewed for Council the status of the PATC expansion project, noting for Council that the project continues to move ahead but that Representative Binkley and Senator Sackett have voiced concern about continuing the project this year because of a potential decline in State operating funds this year. The legislators have indicated that the funds would not be lost to the City if the City decided to hold off on construction this year.

Councilmembers Carpenter and Aloysius expressed their concern that the project was costing too much for what the City was getting for the money.

Councilmember Chris spoke in support of continuing with the project but would consider halting the project if the money could be reallocated for seawall protection.

Councilmembers Warner and Reich noted that the PATC expansion was the City's number one priority for 1985; that to halt the project at this time would most likely result in the killing of the project.

City Manager Widom noted that YKHC is reviewing the feasibility of taking over the operation of PATC.

A discussion took place concerning the difference between a long term treatment facility and a detox/sleep off facility.

M/M by Carpenter, 2nd by Aloysius to table the question of the PATC expansion until the May 13 Council meeting and to set the matter for a public hearing at the May 13 meeting. Voice vote, motion carried.

Item C: Engineers ENGINEERS FOR SEAWALL  
for Seawall

Mayor Bainton introduced the item for discussion by noting that it was necessary for the City Manager and Engineers to establish a working relationship. City Manager Widom reviewed for Council a proposal that, if acceptable to the Engineers and Council, would establish a working relationship among the parties. George Silides of Galliett and Silides agreed to the proposal presented by the City Manager. All parties agreed to the need to get on with the seawall project.
