ORDINANCE #03-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.52.035 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE TO ALLOW EACH CITY COUNCIL MEMBER TO BE APPOINTED TO MORE THAN ONE BOARD, COMMITTEE, OR COMMISSION IF APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 2.52.035 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended as follows (new language is underlined and old language is stricken out):

2.52.035 Appointment, Composition and voting.

A. Membership. The number of members of each board, committee or commission shall be determined by the City Council in the ordinance establishing the body. Unless provided otherwise in the ordinance establishing the body, the city council member of the body shall be a voting member of the body.

B. Appointment. A city council member shall only be appointed to serve on one board, one committee, or one commission, unless a majority of the City Council votes to allow a city council member to serve on more than one board, committee, or commission.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
