SPECIFIC CAPITAL PROJECTS AND SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMS.


WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature under the provisions of Ch. 60, SLA 81
and SLA 82 and AS 37.05.315 has appropriated \$934,838.00 to
the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has the authority to disburse these funds on
Capital Projects and Social Service Programs,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel,
Alaska, that the City of Bethel accepts the Department of Revenue
Municipal Aid Funds totaling \$934,838.00 and agrees to abide by the
conditions of such grants. The City Manager of Bethel, Alaska, is
hereby authorized to secure and implement the grant agreements and to
carry out the terms as specified. The City Manager or Manager designee
or such officers as are required by law or regulation are hereby
authorized to do such acts as are required in connection with the
execution of the grant agreement and the performance of its terms.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council agrees that \$934,838.00
will be expended per attachment "1".

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature under the provisions of Ch. 60, SLA 81 and SLA 82 and AS 37.05.315 has appropriated \$920,823.92 to the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has the authority to disburse these funds on Capital Projects and Social Service programs,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Bethel, Alaska, that the original FY '83 Entitlement Agreement for Municipal Aid be amended so that the following changes are made to the grant allocation statement:

Description Interim partial funding was initially provided. During the interim period, additional data was gathered regarding the extent of child sexual abuse in the Bethel area. Evidence of the problem is brought out by the fact that there has been a 50% increase in reporting child sexual abuse incidents since this project began. Further, teachers are beginning to report incidents, as well as more Bethel residents (instead of mostly from other villages). More boy victims, and adolescents in general, are also now being reported.

The funds will continue to be used for staff salaries, and items which will continue to promote public education and preventative measures.

These items include brochures and booklets, and media equipment.

Description There is located within the city an excellent small library which is run in association with Kuskokwim Community College. The city's responsibility is for the facilities and various non-personnel related operating costs.

These funds will be used to construct a 15' X 20' addition to the library. The additional space will become a quiet reading and writing area. This room will be shut off from voices, telephones and machines and other noises.

Repair of an adjacent wall will also be accomplished. This wall currently lets in wind and exhaust fumes and needs to be strengthened.

Description During the summer months the Kuskokwim River and connecting sloughs within the Bethel City limits are so congested with small boats that a police patrol is much needed. The river patrol helps enforce boat speed limits and other boating laws, promotes boating safety, helps prevent people from operating boats while intoxicated, and aids boats that are stranded or otherwise in trouble.

These funds will be used to expand the river patrol hours of operation so that at the least the heaviest traffic periods are covered regardless of time of day or day of week.

Description Spruce trees planted in cedar boxes will be purchased for community distribution. The boxes can be taken in during the winter months, then returned to the outside each spring until such time as they can survive outdoors year-around.

Also, forty window boxes will be planted and distributed to agencies in the community by the local youth program. They will also care for the boxes and collect them at the end of the summer.
