ORDINANCE #00-13

A ORDINANCE AMENDING 5.20.110 OF THE BMC RELATING TO TAXI FEES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amended. Chapter 5.20.110 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended as follows:

5.20.110 Fees.

The following fees shall be payable to the City of Bethel at the office of the Bethel Taxi Technician at the Police Department [CITY CLERK]:

- A. ~~[\$100.00]~~ 250.00 monthly shall be paid for the issuance or renewal of bus, dispatch service or taxicab permit no later than the 10th of each month.
- B. \$50.00 shall be paid for the issuance of an initial application for chauffeur's license and renewal. The renewal is non-refundable.
- C. ~~[\$100.00]~~ 250.00 monthly shall be paid for the issuance or renewal of a river taxi permit no later than the 10th of each month.
- D. \$50.00 shall be paid for each appeal from the decision of the Bethel Chief of Police to deny or revoke an application for a chauffeur's license. Such fee shall be refunded if the decision of the Bethel Chief of Police is subsequently reversed or if the Transportation Commission does not meet within 15 days of the filing of the appeal. The City Clerk must notify all Transportation Commission members when an appeal is filed. The fee shall be forfeited if the party making the appeal fails to show for the appeal hearing. The fee for filing an appeal may be waived by the City's Finance Director upon receipt of proof that the petitioner cannot afford to pay such a fee.
- E. \$70.00 shall be paid for each application for the transfer of a taxicab permit.

SECTION 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2000.
