A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL TO COVER THE CITY OF BETHEL LIQUOR STORE TAX LIABILITY.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature approved \$26,000.00 for the City Liquor Store Tax Liability, and


WHEREAS, this liability resulted from a community operated store which the Council felt was exempt from tax, but was not so ruled in a tax decision by the courts after two appeals.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the Department of Administration for paying State tax liability on the City liquor store.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of the grant award.
