## RESOLUTION #97-21

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, OBJECTING TO THE SALE OF PULL-TABS FOR THE BENEFIT OF NON-BETHEL-BASED ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, a number of non-profit organizations in Bethel apply for and receive state gaming permits for the sale of pull-tabs to fund their activities; and

WHEREAS, an operator in Bethel has applied for and received a state operator's permit to sell pull-tabs for several outside organizations, in addition to one Bethel-based organization; and


WHEREAS, the net proceeds of pull-tab sales for outside organizations numbers in the tens of thousands of dollars; money that could be put to good use within the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, AS 05.15.124 provides that a municipality may by ordinance prohibit an operator or a vendor from conducting activities under AS 05.15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, that it hereby requests gaming operators to sell pull-tabs only on behalf of Bethel-based non-profit organizations.
