### **ORDINANCE #09-24**

#### **AN ORDINANCE BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FUNDING OF THE DESIGNATED DEFERRED SEAWALL MAINTENANCE ACCOUNT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel ("City") charges a fuel through-put fee, of which \$.02 per gallon is intended to fund seawall maintenance;

**WHEREAS**, the City is required by the Army Corps of Engineers to maintain designated funding of seawall maintenance monies;

**WHEREAS**, it is imperative that funds designated for use in seawall maintenance not be commingled with other funding to ensure availability;

**WHEREAS**, a designated account specifically for deferred seawall maintenance has already been established;

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska; that:

**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is permanent and general in nature and shall be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

**SECTION 2. Amendment.** Section 14.02.095 of the Code is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):

#### **14.02.095 Revenues**


\$.02 of fuel thru put revenue produced by the port shall be transferred to a designated Deferred Sewall Maintenance Account upon payment. All other revenues produced by the port excluding amounts received from fines imposed under this title shall be held in the port enterprise fund for the maintenance and operation of the port.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective no sooner than 60 days and no later than 90 days, after passage of said ordinance.
