A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PROPOSAL OF AND PLANNING OF YUUT ELITNAURVIAT/PEOPLE'S LEARNING CENTER

WHEREAS, The Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta region has a great need for an alternative school and vocational training center such as the Yuut Elitnaurviat/People's Learning Center;

WHEREAS, The Yuut Elitnaurviat/People's Learning Center—a regional-serving alternative school and vocational training center—would serve teens and young adults, providing important linkages and diverse career pathways to secondary and post-secondary education and training to address some of the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta region's most significant labor market needs and employment opportunities;

WHEREAS, The Yuut Elitnaurviat/People's Learning Center would be located in Bethel;

WHEREAS, The Yuut Elitnaurviat/People's Learning Center would make education and training services available to persons originating from all villages in the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta region;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, supports the proposal efforts and planning of the Yuut Elitnaurviat/People's Learning Center.
