A RESOLUTION REQUESTING SFY2007 CAPITAL FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA, VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council, hereinafter called the City, is the governing body of Bethel, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide adequate sanitation facilities for the residents of Bethel, Alaska and has determined the Waste Water treatment facility, West Bethel WTF, FAA Lift Station/FM Upgrades Project to be a number one priority for the community; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Conservation/Village Safe Water Program, hereinafter called VSW, can provide the technical assistance necessary to improve the water and sewer problem,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City hereby requests the Governor and Legislature appropriate \$10,000,000 through the VSW Program to design and build the Waste Water treatment facility, West Bethel WTF, FAA Lift Station/FM Upgrades Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the City hereby authorizes VSW or its representatives to enter upon or cross community land for the purposes of assisting the City in carrying out this Waste Water treatment facility, West Bethel WTF, FAA Lift Station/FM Upgrades Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City will cooperate with the provisions of needed agreements entered into between the City and VSW, and that said provisions will be duly carried out.


