**RESOLUTION #00-09**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DOT/PF CONVERT  
WATSON'S CORNER TO AN ALL-WAY STOP SIGN INTERSECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway and Ridgecrest Drive, commonly known as "Watson's Corner", has only one stop sign which creates traffic problems; and

**WHEREAS**, rehabilitation of the highway and installation of a stoplight is three years away; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel has asked that DOT/PF install stop signs at Watson's Corner;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, requests that DOT/PF convert Watson's Corner to an "all-way stop sign intersection" and to paint stop lines and cross walks on the pavement at these corners.

**PASSED AND APPROVED THIS 9<sup>th</sup> DAY OF MAY 2000, by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.**
