#### **A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE NAPAKIAK/BETHEL ROAD STUDY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel wishes to promote the orderly and efficient development of the regions transportation infrastructure; and


**WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities completed the "Bethel to Napakiak Road Reconnaissance Study" in 1981. This study investigated possible routes for the connecting road, design characteristics of the proposed road, material resources for its construction and its cost-to-benefit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Native Village of Napakiak has retained Kuskokwim Architects and Engineers, Inc. (KAE) to continue the road study; and

**WHEREAS**, KAE purports that it will show better methods and reduced costs of construction, and a more positive socio-economic climate for the roads need.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the City Council of Bethel, Alaska supports the continued effort in determining the feasibility of the Napakiak to Bethel road.
