## RESOLUTION #95-03

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING LOCAL MATCH MONIES FOR THE BETHEL BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT FOR FISCAL YEAR 96

WHEREAS, the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project was authorized by Congress in section 601 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-662); and

WHEREAS, Bethel is the largest community in western Alaska and is the regional center of government, service and commerce for communities throughout the Yukon-Kuskokwim delta; and


WHEREAS, Congress has appropriated \$14.7 million dollars for stabilizing the bank of the Kuskokwim River at Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' number one priority for civil works projects in Alaska is the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has a balance for Corps of Engineers match funds for projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council requests an appropriation of \$1.5 million for Fiscal Year 96 local match for the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project from the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, to ensure that the \$1.5 million identified in the Corps match program is committed to this project.
