ORDINANCE #09-07

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY'S PURCHASE OF A PETERBUILT/MAMMOTH 34-CY REFUSE TRUCK, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 4.20 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE

- WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel is in dire need of a 34 Cubic Yard replacement Refuse Truck and is seeking funding for the acquisition of equipment through a Municipal lease purchase agreement or direct conventional financing;
- WHEREAS,** The Refuse truck is available only through special order by the City of Bethel and must be manufactured to meet the cities specific specifications. Refuse trucks are not stock items for truck dealers or dumpster manufactures;
- WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel must place an order to manufacture as soon as possible, due to the timelines Peterbuilt and MAMMOTH requires to schedule the assemble of the unit and meet calendar year 2009 barge schedules;
- WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel needs to receive the replacement Refuse Truck in the summer of 2009 in order to ensure the continuation of uninterrupted Dumpster/Refuse service for the citizens of Bethel;
- WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel is temporarily amending the Bethel Municipal Code to allow the financing, ordering, purchase, and receipt of in calendar year 2009;

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification: This ordinance is not permanent or general in nature and shall not be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Chapter 4.20 of the Bethel Municipal Code shall not apply to this purchase of a Peterbuilt/Mammoth 34 CY Refuse Truck;

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby approves the purchase of one, Peterbuilt/Mammoth 34 CY Refuse Truck by granting their approval for the City Administration to conclude the purchase.

SECTION 4. Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
