### **ORDINANCE #03-03**

#### **A ORDINANCE PLACING THE QUESTION OF WHETHER TO APPROVE A CITY OWNED LIQUOR STORE ON THE OCTOBER 7, 2003 BALLOT**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

**SECTION 1. Classification.** This ordinance is temporary in nature and shall not be incorporated into the Bethel Municipal Code.

**SECTION 2. Election.** The City Clerk shall place the following proposition on the October 7, 2003 ballot to be presented to the voters of the City of Bethel:

#### **Proposition**

#### **CITY OWNED LIQUOR STORE**

Shall the City of Bethel remove the local option currently in effect, that prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages, and adopt in its place a local option that prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages except on premises owned by the City of Bethel under a package store liquor license?
