Minutes of the January Meeting read and approved.

December Meeting minutes yo be located and read in March Meeting.

Comment in letter from City attorney regarding reading of ordinances is not completely clear. Council to ask for clarification as well as request opinion whether the City can legally do business under the Name "City of Bethel".

Mayor appoints new members to Police Committee: Jean C. Persons, Robert Ellis, Darlo Walton, Allan Haferbecker, by recommendation of Mr. Gamble.

If found that State Policeman still is using the designated office in the jailbuilding, the State is to be requested to pay \$25.00 per month rent.

Shantz moves that members of the jury in recent Court case be payed one dollar each for their services. Gamble seconds. All members are in favor after poll of votes.

Council to contact prospective telephone operators to find party interested in installing system.

Streetlight across from Shantz is to be tranferred across the street.

Loose dog problem is to be put on the agende for next (March) meeting.

The bank shall be contacted to locate best source for investment of funds not immediately needed by the Council.

Shantz states that Civel Defense Siren is being repaired in Anchorage.

Shantz has completed description of location for garbage dump. Application for withdrawal will be asked for from Bureau of Land Management.

Smit explaines light situation. New streelights have been installed in various locations. Mercury vapor unit was placed at ACS building. Members will inspect this unit to see if results warrant added cost for future installations.

Smit moves that Eddie Hoffman be hired to level the garbage dump with his Cat for a period not exceeding three hours. Gamble seconds. Mmbers are polled, none opposed.

Dept. of Health shall be contacted to ask uotline for mosquito controll.

Mayor appoints Albert Schmidt, Schattschneider, Jack Smith, Donald Shantz, Alfred Laroux and Douglas Vollertson as members of the Fire Committee.

Meeting is automatically adjourned at ten pm.
