ORDINANCE #00-21

**AN ORDINANCE PLACING THE ISSUE OF AN ALCOHOL DELIVERY SITE ON
THE OCTOBER 3, 2000 BALLOT**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Bethel has considered the question of whether or not the City of Bethel should establish an alcohol delivery site in Bethel; and

WHEREAS the City Council seeks input from Bethel citizens regarding this question;

SECTION 1. Classification. This Ordinance is not permanent and should not be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Election. The City Clerk shall place the following proposition on the October 3, 2000, ballot to be presented to the voters of the City of Bethel:

Alcohol Delivery Site

Should the Bethel City Council enact an ordinance establishing an Alcohol Delivery Site in Bethel? An Alcohol Delivery Site ordinance would include various requirements. Some of the requirements are: (1) a person would need a permit to obtain alcohol in Bethel; (2) all alcohol imported into Bethel above certain minimums would go directly to the Alcohol Delivery Site and be redelivered only to persons with permits; (3) all alcohol delivered to Bethel from a package or liquor store would go directly to the Alcohol Delivery Site and be redelivered only to persons with permits; (4) individuals convicted of certain alcohol related crimes would not be able to obtain permits to get alcohol at the Alcohol Delivery Site.


AGAINST an Alcohol Delivery Site

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
