### **Resolution # 11-12**

#### **A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA AGREEING TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ASSOCIATION OF VILLAGE COUNCIL PRESIDENTS AND THE CITY OF BETHEL DATED JUNE 7, 2011 THROUGH JUNE 6, 2011**

**WHEREAS**, the Association of Village Council Presidents (AVCP) operated the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program (TANF);

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel through its Parks and Recreation department has managed the Bethel 4-H Youth Center Program for the past 15 years with an average attendance of 300-400 youth participants;

**WHEREAS**, the AVCP TANF program has received grant funding to provide assistance to youth programs, such as the Bethel 4-H Youth Center Program;

**WHEREAS**, AVCP TANF desires to provide grant funds to the City in the amount of \$48,280 to fund one temporary employee at the City of Bethel 4-H Youth Center Program for 2010;

**WHEREAS**, in exchange for the AVCP TANF Grand Fund payment, the City agrees to perform the duties and obligations identified in the Memorandum of Agreement dated June 7, 2010 through June 6, 2011;

**WHEREAS**, an agreement was not in place for the funding source for 2010 therefore this agreement would ratify the active acknowledgment between the two parties;

**WHEREAS**, this agreement is necessary to insure funding from AVCP is in compliance with grant obligations further allowing for the funds to be received by the City of Bethel;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council of the City of Bethel agrees to the terms of the Memorandum of Agreement dated June 7, 2010 through June 6, 2011 between the Association of Village Council Presidents and the City of Bethel and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement in accordance to the terms of the agreement.


