

CANVASS BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 5, 1972

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Guinn at 8:15 p.m., KVNA Building.

ROLL CALL

Present: Cooke, Guinn, Hoffman, Murphy, Zahradnicek.
Absent: Dale, Romer

The purpose of the meeting was to canvass the election, which was held October 3, 1972.

The clerk presented to council the tally books and certification of the tally for examination. She handed them the absentee ballots which were returned. Eleven (11) were sent out with ten (10) returning. A list of the voters are a permanent part of the minutes.

M/M Zahradnicek, Murphy, we accept the 10 absentee ballots.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Councilman Murphy and Councilwoman Cooke processed the 10 ballots into the ballot box and returned the outside envelope.

The clerk presented Council with the first batch of question ballots. She explained that these ballots were questioned before the updated registration list arrived on the afternoon flight. Councilman Zahradnicek and Mayor Guinn rechecked the registration list on those questioned voters. There was a stack of 4 questioned ballots that were not on the list, but were registered according to our Election District Office in Nome.

M/M Murphy, Cooke, we accept the 4 ballots that were not on the list.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

The clerk showed the Council the four ballots that she and the Election Supervisor had decided were not registered and recommended not to accept.

M/M Zahradnicek, Murphy, we accept the Election Boards recommendation and consider the four ballots rejected.

M/Passed by unanimous voice vote.

There was one questioned ballot that had some confusion on the voter registration card. The Nome Election Supervisor recommended to accept it as a valid ballot.

M/M Zahradnicek, Cooke, Jay Elford be accepted as a registered voter.

M/Passed by unanimous voice vote.

A list of all questioned ballots are made a permanent part of these minutes.

All councilmembers separated the ballots and tallied the votes.

Mayor Guinn read the results to the audience. He explained there would have to

be a run off between George Ileck and Darrel Connick., due to the fact that Mr. Connick did not get 40 % of the total voter cast.

M/M Zahradnicek, Cooke we accept the election as a Canvass Board and accept a seat two (2) run-off which be scheduled for the next Tuesday, 17 October, 1972.


Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.


M/M Zahradnicek, Hoffman to adjourn.
