ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES OF PROCEDURE, CERTAIN DEFINITIONS, AND BY-LAWS FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL, AND PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN AMENDMENTS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:

Section I. That Resolution Number Four (4) of the City of Bethel be, and hereby is, in its entirety, hereby fixed, known and promulgated as Ordinance Number Thirty-Six (36) of the City of Bethel.

Section II. That Ordinance Number Thirty-Six (36) of the City of Bethel be amended herein, in such manner as follows:

1. Repeal Sentence 1, Rule 18b.
2. Add the following description of the duties of the City Administrator:
  - (a) Empowering clause. The City is empowered under the City of Bethel By-Law #4, this Ordinance, and is further empowered under SL29.25.190, to appoint a City Administrator.
  - (b) Such City Administrator shall have the following duties and powers, which are permanently at the pleasure of the City Council:
    1. Manage the business of the City; be responsible for the care and maintenance of the City's real and personal property, and its interests; hire and fire City employees excepting those who handle City funds.
    2. Plan the economic and orderly development of the community; execute its governing ordinances and resolutions; present new ordinances and resolutions to the Council.
    3. Engineer the contracting, construction and completion of all City buildings, projects and programs; sub-contract necessary and proper City work.
    4. Aid and abet the purposes and designs of the City in all matters; encourage and apply to all State and Federal agencies that can aid the City in the fulfillment of its purposes and designs.
    5. Act as the executor of the City's public relations in connection with Federal, State or other officials, Chamber of Commerce activities, or other such related situations.
    6. Edit and publish the Bethel City News until such time as a private responsible concern is willing and able to assume its functions.
    7. Hold co-responsibility with the City Clerk for control of the City books and submission of an annual budget.

8. Execute City policies and submit new policies, if necessary, to the Council, for recreation, sanitation, police, fire protection, civil defense, and the general health and welfare of the people of Bethl.
