#### **A RESOLUTION GIVING WRITTEN NOTICE OF CITY'S INTENT TO REIMBURSE CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR COURT COMPLEX EXPANSION PROJECT WITH PROCEEDS OF TAX-EXEMPT DEBT**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska (the "City"), wishes to declare, on behalf of the City, the City's official intent to reimburse certain expenditures with proceeds of tax-exempt debt to be incurred by the City;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, as follows:

Section 1. The City reasonably expects to appropriate funds from the General Fund to pay costs of the courthouse complex expansion project and to reimburse such fund for such expenditures with the proceeds of tax-exempt debt to be incurred by the City (the "Reimbursement Bonds").


Section 2. The maximum principal amount of Reimbursement Bonds expected to be issued for the project described in Section 1 is \$3,250,000.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval as required by law.
