RESOLUTION #01-34

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CAPITAL FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM – KASAYULI SUBDIVISION WATER & SEWER FEASIBILITY STUDY

WHEREAS, the City Council, herein after called the Council, is governing the body of the City of Bethel, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to provide adequate water and sewer facilities for the residents of Bethel, Alaska and has determined this water and sewer feasibility study to be in the best interest for the community; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment Conservation/Village Safe Water Program, hereinafter called VSW, can provide the technical assistance necessary to improve the city's water and sewer facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Yukon Kuskokwim Health Corporation, owner and developer of Kasayuli Subdivision, developed a 6-inch well within the subdivision in 1999. The feasibility study is required now to determine the size, type, and cost of a new water treatment plant, and potentially, a piped water distribution system. The feasibility study will assist the City of Bethel in determining the timing and method of placing the existing well into production, if it within the Bethel Water and Sewer Master Plan Update of 1996 by Dames and Moore; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and VSW will study the feasibility of constructing a new water treatment plant (WTP) to be located in Kasayuli Subdivision. The project will evaluate the cost and benefits of a new WTP to supply water to city haul trucks versus constructing a piped distribution system within the subdivision. The study will also look at the feasibility of a piped wastewater collection and disposal system, if it within the Bethel Water and Sewer Master Plan Update of 1996 by Dames and Moore.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby requests the Governor and Legislature appropriate \$100,000 through the VSW Program to complete the Kasayuli Subdivision Water & Sewer Feasibility study.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes VSW or its representatives to enter upon or cross community land for the purposes of assisting the Council in carrying out this study.


