ACCEPTANCE AND APPROVAL OF MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN ASSOCIATION OF VILLAGE COUNCIL PRESIDENTS AND THE CITY OF BETHEL REGARDING TEMPORARY EMPLOYEE FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Association of Village Council Presidents (AVCP) administers the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Program (TANF);

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel, through its Parks and Recreation Department, has managed the Bethel 4-H Youth Center Program for the past 15 years with an average yearly participation of 300-400 youth;

WHEREAS, the AVCP TANF program can provide financial assistance to youth programs, such as the Bethel 4-H Youth Center Program;


WHEREAS, AVCP desires to provide \$48,280 in TANF grant funding to the City to cover the salary of one temporary employee hired under the City of Bethel 4-H Youth Center Program for the period June 7, 2011 to June 30, 2012;

WHEREAS, in exchange for the AVCP TANF grant fund payment, the City agrees to perform the duties and obligations delineated in the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between AVCP and the City, effective June 7, 2011;

WHEREAS, the MOA is necessary to meet AVCP TANF funding requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council accepts and approves the Memorandum of Agreement between the Association of Village Council Presidents and the City of Bethel, effective June 7, 2011, concerning the use of AVCP TANF funds to cover the salary of one temporary employee hired under the Bethel 4-H Youth Center Program.
