Ordinance #10-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 5.20.160 GENERAL PROVISIONS, OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, Bethel Municipal Code Section 4.16.040 Exemptions, states under Q, The sale of services of transporting passengers by river taxi, taxicab, bus, commercial airline, air charter, air taxi, hover craft or limousine is exempt. The lease of vehicle for hire permits are not exempt.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED That The Bethel City Council Increase Taxi Fares.

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Chapter 5.20.160 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended as follows: (old language is stricken out):

5.20.160 Fees.

A. One hundred eighty-five (\$185), ~~in lieu of sales tax~~, fares shall be paid monthly to the transportation inspector for the issuance or renewal of a bus, limousine, dispatch service, or taxicab permit no later than the tenth (10th) of each month.

SECTION 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
