

Minutes of City Council Meeting  
January 6, 1964

At the National Guard Armory  
8:00 P.M.

Present: Swanson, Mendola, Schirmer, Weise, Hoffman & Baker

The minutes of the December 2nd meeting were read and approved as read.

MMS/Weise, Mendola that the letters of December 17th and 22nd from Fairbanks Insurance Agency be replied to by telegram early tomorrow morning requesting telegraphic reply about the total cost of \$125 per year for accident policy on volunteer firemen as specified in the above-mentioned letters; to determine whether the cost is per fireman or for the whole department. Also to find out the maximum number of firemen this policy will cover. Mendola, Schirmer, Weise, Hoffman and Baker in favor.

Donald Schirmer, Ben Wilkens, Art Nicholson and Donald Baker were appointed as a committee to report about Sanitation conditions.

It was reported that Pensgard paid his past-due/sales tax. A decision was reached to give Max Lieb until the<sup>city</sup> end of February to pay his delinquent taxes and that the city clerk would write him a letter stating such. It was decided to hold a special city council meeting whenever James Litto came to Bethel to discuss with him the payment of Tundra Telephone's delinquent city sales tax.

MMS/Schirmer, Hoffman that the city council accept the Articles of Incorporation and By-Law of Bethel Sales Inc. as posted and read. MC.

Liquor ordinance was read.

MMS/Mendola, Schirmer that Section 3 be changed to permit type registration over serial numbering system. Mendola, Schirmer, Baker, Weise and Hoffman in favor.

MMS/Mendola, Hoffman that Ordinance 22 for the City of Bethel be accepted as per first reading. MC

MMS/Weise, Hoffman that the sum of \$187.50 be appropriated for a light to be used for the liquor store. Location to be settled between City of Bethel and Bethel Sales, Inc. Schirmer, Baker, Hoffman, Mendola & Weise in favor.

MMS/Schirmer, Weise that the meeting be continued. MC.

MMS/Weise, Schirmer that the city dump be moved off of the road for a cost of not more than \$125.00. Schirmer, Weise, Mendola, Baker, and Hoffman in favor.

The Mayor was requested to write to the Governor recommending Max Fancher to the Armory Board.

MMS/Schirmer, Weise that the City Council meetings be held the second Monday of each month beginning in February. A monthly treasurer's report to be given at each meeting, for the previous month. MC.

MMS/Schirmer, Hoffman that the meeting be adjourned. MC.
