A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA ENDORSING THE WORK OF THE WESTERN ALASKA SALMON COALITION ON THE INTERCEPTION OF WESTERN ALASKAN SALMON ON THE OPEN SEAS.


WHEREAS, the Western Alaska Salmon Coalition is concerned about Western Alaska salmon being caught by other fisheries as an incidental catch on the open seas; and

WHEREAS, the incidental catch of Western Alaskan salmon on the open seas has a detrimental affect on the subsistence and commercial fisheries of Western Alaska; and

WHEREAS, subsistence and commercial salmon fishing are of vital economic concern to Bethel and the villages within the Kuskokwim River drainage area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA DOES HEREBY ENDORSE THE WORK OF THE WESTERN ALASKA SALMON COALITION CONCERNING THE INTERCEPTION OF WESTERN ALASKAN SALMON ON THE OPEN SEAS.
