

MINUTES OF VILLAGE COUNCIL MEETING

Meeting called to order by Chairman, Howard Elliott at 8:10 p.m.

Howard Elliott asked if there were any objections to the Village Council hiring a Village Policeman. This was the second time the Council asked for objection. James Hoffman explained what some of the duties of a village police would be; to enforce Village Ordinances and work with the local Deputy U. S. Marshal and U. S. Commissioner. No objections voiced. Jack Wiese suggested that a car be furnished the police to patrol the Village.

Powers of the Village Council was read by Agnes Harrison.

James Hoffman made a motion that the Council accept applications for a City Police.

Elliott asked for a vote .
