A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT A \$30,000 SUB-GRANT AWARD FROM THE ASSOCIATION OF VILLAGE COUNCIL PRESIDENTS, INC. TO FUND SUPERVISED YOUTH ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the Association of Village Council Presidents, Inc., a regional non-profit corporation located in Bethel, Alaska, issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) that sought projects providing community wellness, healthy, alcohol/drug-free activities for children;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel, Parks and Recreation Department, Bethel Youth Center/4-H Program responded to the RFP and requested \$30,000 to fund a project titled, *July: Celebration of Youth in Bethel*, that contains safe, healthy, supervised activities for young people in Bethel;

WHEREAS, money from this sub-grant will supplement the City's Parks and Recreation budget by covering the costs of family activities on the Fourth of July at Pinky's Park;

WHEREAS, additional Bethel Youth Center staff will be hired so that Bethel's teenagers who are able to be accompanied by an adult after curfew will be able to visit the Youth Center until midnight, Tuesday through Saturday, for the month of July 2005;


WHEREAS, the Bethel Youth Center will offer free art and cooking classes to teenagers, two Saturday dances with a live DJ, and weekly billiard and chess tournaments with prizes for the winners;

WHEREAS, the \$30,000 award for this project must be spent by July 31, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council accepts the \$30,000 sub-grant award from the Association of Village Council Presidents, Inc. to fund the *July: Celebration of Youth in Bethel* project to be administered by the City's Parks and Recreation Department, Bethel Youth Center/4-H Program.


