A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, DIVISION OF CORRECTIONS TO CONTINUE CONTRACTING WITH THE CITY OF BETHEL FOR OPERATION OF THE STATE JAIL AT THE TIME THE EXISTING JAIL FACILITY IS REPLACED BY A NEW FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has been contracting with the State of Alaska for operation of the Bethel State Jail and proven to be more than competent to operate such a facility; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is interested in providing the service with an absolute minimum of duplication; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is interested in continuing to contract for the operation of the proposed new State Jail Facility to be located in Bethel, Alaska.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Administration be directed to negotiate with the Department of Health and Social Services, Division of Corrections, to continue to contract for the operation of the Bethel State Jail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative.
