**A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS
OF BETHEL NATIVE CORPORATION TO SEEK FUNDING FOR REMEDIATION OF
THE FORMER BIA ADMINISTRATION SITE**

WHEREAS, the former BIA administration site in Bethel has had a history of environmental problems including contamination from diesel oil spills, asbestos, and PCBs;

WHEREAS, a fire of unknown origin destroyed several of the remaining buildings at the former BIA Administration Site in Bethel;


WHEREAS, Bethel Native Corporation and several individual Native Allotees, as adjacent landowners, are concerned about neighboring environmental hazards and any adverse impact on their lands;

WHEREAS, the Department of Fish and Wildlife is currently responsible for the site and without financial means to clean it up;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council supports the efforts of the Bethel Native Corporation to seek funding from Senator Murkowski for remediation of the former BIA administration site.


