REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 24, 1968

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Arthur Nicholson.

Present: Bruce Crow, Art Dull, Ed Hoffman, Arthur Nicholson, David Swanson
Absent: J.B. Haroldsen, Al Laroux

By the request of the Council Members, the reading of the minutes and all other preliminaries were dispensed with.

Discussion was held between Council and Mr. Shepard of the Governor's Office and Mr. Stocking of the Corps of Engineers concerning the Sea Wall.

Motion was made by Bruce Crow, seconded by Ed Hoffman, "that the Council request the Governor's Office to assist us both technically and financially in surveying the critical erosion problem in Bethel and to encourage whatever agencies can be of assistance."

Poll Vote-5 ayes 0 nays Passed Unanimously

Motion was made by Bruce Crow, seconded by Ed Hoffman, "that the Mayor and the City Administrator be instructed forthwith to negotiate a right-of-way and a construction of the new section of the road to skirt the eroded area and that the City Administrator be authorized to expend whatever funds necessary to construct this road, including the moving of the Moravian Mission Warehouse."

Poll Vote-5 ayes 0 nays Motion passed unanimously.

Due to the fact that the Council lost its quorum, the meeting was adjourned.
