

RESOLUTION #317

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, APPOINTING, FROM THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE MUNICIPALITY, JUDGES OF ELECTIONS IN PRECINCT NUMBERS: ONE, TWO, AND THREE.

WHEREAS, the duty of the City Council, pursuant to Section 2.44.100 of Chapter 2.4 (Elections) of the Bethel Code of Ordinances, is to appoint, from the qualified electors of the City of Bethel, at least three (3) but not more than five (5) judges of election in each precinct, at a regular or special meeting held at least seven (7) days previous to the date of holding the election, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council is required by the aforesaid Section of the Bethel Code of Ordinances to designate one (1) judge in each precinct as a chairperson of the judges appointed and to constitute all judges selected as the Board of Election for the General Election to be held on October 7, 1980, in Bethel, Alaska.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the Municipality of Bethel hereby appoints, from the qualified electors of the City of Bethel, the following judges of election in each precinct within the Municipality's jurisdictional boundaries, three (3) of whom are designated as chairpersons, and all appointees shall constitute the Board of Election for the General Election to be held on October 7, 1980 in Bethel, Alaska.


