WHEREAS, Patti Waters was instrumental in bringing E911 service to the community of Bethel;


WHEREAS, Patti Waters developed policies and procedures for seamless communications between the Fire Department, Police Department, State Troopers Department, and other Public Safety entities;

WHEREAS, Patti Waters selected, hired, and trained highly competent and professional people to provide the highest level of Public Safety Services to the citizens of Bethel;


