A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS LIMITED REEVALUATION REPORT ON THE BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, Bethel is the only port on the southwestern Alaska mainland for oceangoing barges and ships, and the supply center for surrounding villages; and

WHEREAS, the Bank Stabilization Project for Bethel will stabilize the Kuskokwim River bank by placing rock rip-rap over a filter fabric in the wave and ice zone; and

WHEREAS, this project will benefit the residents of Bethel and prevent social disruptions associated with losing homes or businesses, or moving to new locations; and

WHEREAS, the City Dock and the Petro-Port are essential for waterborne commerce as a distribution center; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska District, Corps of Engineers has completed its Limited Reevaluation Report which updates the economic analysis of the Bank Stabilization Project; and


WHEREAS, the existing conditions for economic evaluation of the project have not changed significantly since the Corps drafted a General Design Memorandum in 1988; and

WHEREAS, there is no significant environmental impact based on the Corps environmental assessment.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council supports and endorses the Limited Reevaluation Report dated April 1993.
