REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING March 9, 1970

The meeting was called to order by Acting Mayor Eddie Hoffman. Roll was called.

The minutes of the previous meetings were read. A correction was made on the Special Meeting of March 2: Crow voted no on the motion that he act as spokesman for the City Council at the A.T.C. hearing.

COMMUNICATIONS: Snodgrass read a letter from the State Dept. of Administration with \$12,194.00 enclosed for revenue sharing; a letter from Robert Graham asking a representative from the City to attend the Curriculum Planning meetings at the school.

This item was directed to the Land Planning Committee.

M/M Hoffman, Peltola that the Community Liquor Sales donate \$100 to the Senior Class for graduation gowns.

RESTAURANT LICENSE:

M/M Murphy, Baxter to table Gerald Nicholson's application for Liquor License until further meetings since Community Liquor Sales has five applications



pending.

LOAN TO DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION:

M/M Peltola, Murphy to table this item until further information is received from the city attorney. Unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS:

CITY PARK:

Mrs. Jepson of the Women's Club asked for use of city land for a park.

M/M Baxter, Peltola that his item be placed in joint committee: Recreation and Land Planning. Unanimous.

BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LICENSE:

M/M Baxter, Peltola that this item be tabled until formal application has been made by Ben Dale. Unanimous.

LIQUOR LICENSES:

M/M Peltola, Baxter that this item be tabled until a location of their establishments be defined and a hearing is held with Amerilaska Inc., the applicants. Unanimous.

BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LICENSE:

M/M Peltola, Baxter that Art Nicholson's application for liquor license be tabled until after the City Council meets with their attorney and with Nicholson. Unanimous.

M/M Crow, Peltola that the City invite a legal representative of the State A.B.C. Board to meet with the council and citizens of Bethel at an early date to resolve their mutual responsibilities. Unanimous.

M/M Peltola, Baxter for adjournment. Meeting adjourned.
