June 29, 1966

The Bethel City Council should give ADH permission to use the ground now housing the Bethel Health Clinic for the relocation of the pink trailer under the lease now in effect or under any new lease to be signed with N.C. Co. Results: T. Christiansen-yes, H. Elliot-yes, E. Hoffman-yes, J. Andrew-yes, A. Nicholson-yes, A. Laroux-not available.

The Bethel City Council should approve the donation of one load of sand at \$20 to be used in relocation of the ADH clinic to the middle of town. Results same as above. Unanimous.

As under the contract of the City Sanitation Employees there is no allowance for a paid Fourth of July holiday, the Council approves a paid holiday for July 4, 1966 with the stipulation that the sanitation employees give the required regular Monday service to those customers in need on either the previous Saturday or following Tues. of the 4th. Results same as above. Unanimous.

As the 1965-66 fiscal budget for payment of Jail Guard salaries is now overspent, the Council authorizes Lynda Scott, City Clerk to pay the jail guards for the period of June 16-30th, 1966 at the regular scale of pay which is \$1.65/hour.
