MINUTES

City of Bethel, Special Council Meeting

April 6, 1998

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Phillips called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. at the City Offices Conference Room.

II. ROLL CALL

III. PEOPLE TO BE HEARD

No one was signed up to speak to the Council.

Council member Rodgers stated that for the record he "would like for Mr. Notti to retract the statements made against Dave Trantham, and at this time, ask the Mayor to direct Mr. Notti to apologize to Mr. Trantham". Council member Notti responded saying that if he decided to retract his statement, he would apologize at that time. Council member O'Brien stated it is because of things like this that people in the community feel intimidated to come address the Council. Other Council members made further comments. Prior to the Mayor apologizing to Mr. Trantham on behalf of the entire Council, Council members Rodgers, O'Brien, Anvil, Williams, and Sanchez-Pobrislo apologized personally to Mr. Trantham.

Mr. Rodgers thanked Mr. Trantham for showing up to the meetings.



motion M/M by Rodgers, 2nd by O'Brien, to adjourn the meeting at 8:21 p.m.


