
### **RESOLUTION #01-02**


#### **A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF BETHEL STRATEGIC PLAN FOR COMPUTERS AND NETWORKING**

- WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel was approached by United Utilities, Inc., with a free offer for a six-month wireless demonstration project for City offices; and
- WHEREAS,** The City Council felt they could not accept this offer without first understanding the computer and networking needs of City offices; and
- WHEREAS,** The City Council created a Technology Task Force to research and outline the needs and goals of City offices in regard to computers and networking; and
- WHEREAS,** The Technology Task Force spent many months researching and creating a Bethel Strategic Plan for Computers and Networking and determined United Utilities' free wireless demonstration would dovetail in with the needs of City offices; and
- WHEREAS,** The Technology Task Force recommends the Bethel Strategic Plan for Computers and Networking be adopted by the City of Bethel; and
- WHEREAS,** The City Council accepted United Utilities' free demonstration for wireless technology for City offices at the November 21, 2000 Council meeting; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, hereby adopts the City of Bethel Strategic Plan for Computers and Networking.
