**ORDINANCE #01-34**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PURCHASE AND SALE OF A 28 BY 40 FOOT BUILDING FROM THE ALASKA MORAVIAN CHURCH**

**WHEREAS** the Alaska Moravian Church owns a 28 by 40 foot building that the City of Bethel wishes to purchase and renovate for Bethel Police Department services;

**WHEREAS** the building would be renovated and used to house the Department of Motor Vehicles office, records storage, property storage, and evidence storage;

**WHEREAS** the Police Department currently does not have adequate space for all of the services that it provides;

**WHEREAS** the purchase of the Moravian Church's building is in the best interests of the City and its citizens because it will provide additional space for the Bethel Police Department;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

**SECTION 1. Classification.** This ordinance is not permanent or general in nature and shall not be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

**SECTION 2. Authorization.** In accordance with section 4.08.020 of the Bethel Municipal Code, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the attached Purchase and Sale Agreement to purchase the 28 by 40 foot building from the Alaska Moravian Church.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
