A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL ENDORSING THE RECOMMENDATIONS MADE AT THE "WALK YOUR TALK" TOWN MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 1995.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Bethel recognize the problems caused by alcoholism and public drunkenness; and

WHEREAS, a meeting of 56 concerned citizens took place on November 7, 1995, and the citizens present voted to submit the following items to the City Council for their consideration:

- 1) The Citizens of Bethel should not have to put up with or tolerate continued public drunkenness, and the City Council should take all necessary action and pass necessary ordinances and support new laws, to deal with this type of behavior.
- 2) The Bethel City Council should investigate existing laws that allow Local Option Communities to establish a central delivery site for incoming alcohol.
- 3) The Bethel City Council should hire two additional police officers to deal with the investigations, arrests, and convictions of bootleggers

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska hereby acknowledges the recommendations made by the "Walk your Talk" attendees, and pledges to discuss the issues brought forth and to do everything in our power to deal with and lend support to this battle
