ACCEPT AND APPROVE AN SFY 2011 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5311 GRANT AWARD FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and Orutsararmiut Native Council started the Bethel Transit System in April 2008 and it began picking up passengers on November 10, 2008;

WHEREAS, the Bethel Transit System provides 80 to 90 rides per day to adults and children, six days a week, at minimal cost, and serves a special group of people with cognitive and physical disabilities, senior citizens, and youth;


WHEREAS, the Bethel Transit System offers timely, convenient rides Monday through Friday by serving 29 stops a route and 21 stops a route on Saturdays;

WHEREAS, the transit system relies on grant funding to pay for its administrative, operating, and capital expenditures;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel applied for and was awarded an SFY 2011 Federal Transit Administration Section 5311 grant in the amount of \$261,503 to pay for administrative and operating expenses related to the public transit system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council accepts and approves the SFY 2011 FTA Section 5311 grant in the amount of \$261,503 from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and promises to comply with all grant requirements.
