AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TAXIS AND BUSES IN THE CITY OF BETHEL, PROVIDING PENALTIES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be it enacted by the Council of the City of Bethel:

Sec. I. That no taxi or bus operator shall operate taxis and/or buses in the City of Bethel, for the purposes of transporting passengers, unless such operator is authorized by a permit of the City of Bethel.

Sec. II. Operators of taxis or buses will be granted a City permit by the City Clerk under the following conditions:

- (a) Presentation of proof that the operator is properly licensed to drive in Alaska, and is 21 years of age.
- (b) Subscription to a statement attesting to the fact that the operator is not addicted to intoxicants or narcotics; and attesting to the fact that the operator has not been convicted of a felony for ten (10) years prior to his permit application to the City, or a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, or a misdemeanor involving a minor; and attesting to the fact that the operator has not been in an auto accident involving death or serious injury to passengers while the operator was driving, in the last ten years.
- (c) Presentation of Copies of the personal and property damage insurance policy(s) covering the vehicle(s) for which the operator will be granted a City permit. Such vehicle(s) will be listed on the operator's permit prepared by the City Clerk.
- (d) Presentation of the permit fee of five dollars (\$5.00).

Sec. III. Operators shall be responsible for maintaining a written daily record of the number of passengers carried, and the total cash received in fares per day, for sales tax purposes. [This written daily record shall be submitted by the operator or operator's employee, if any, with the quarterly tax return to the City of Bethel.]

Sec. IV. The City permit for taxi and/or bus operators is non-transferrable, and permits the operator to drive only the vehicles so specified on his permit.

Sec. ~~V~~^(of V) (a) Violation of Section I, Section III or Section IV of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor for each violation.

(b) Presentation of ~~fraudulent~~ material under Section IIIa, IIb or IIc of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.

(c) The City reserves the right to revoke an operator's bus and/or taxi permit upon that operator committing a misdemeanor, or upon his conviction for a felony, or negligent driving, ~~or negligent driving.~~

Sec. VI This Ordinance shall be in effect THIRTY days after Council approval.

Section III:

the City Clerk of the City of Bethel upon the City Clerk's
request.

Section V:

(a) No taxi or bus operator shall purchase
intoxicating liquor from any retail liquor outlet in the
City of Bethel during that operator's normal working
hours.

ORDINANCE # 41

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TAXIS IN THE CITY
OF BETHEL, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE #~~37~~ 31

Be it Enacted by the City Council of the City of Bethel:

That the following section be known as Section 3(b) of
Ordinance 37 of the City of Bethel:

SECTION: The written daily record shall be composed of three
elements separately and clearly noted on the record--the time
of the fare, the number of passengers in the fare, and the
total cash amount of the fare.

VIOLATION: Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be in effect THIRTY days
after Council approval.
